## CONTEXT

Green Purchasing was recognized in Agenda 21, adopted at the 1992 United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED Earth Summit), as an effective approach not only to minimize of environmental impacts but also shift toward sustainable consumption and production.

The International Green Purchasing Network (IGPN) (http://www.igpn.org) is a global multi-stakeholder partnership, initiated by Professor Ryoichi Yamamoto launched by Japan Green Purchasing Network in 2005 with its mission:

(a) Promote globally the development of environmentally friendly products and services and green purchasing activities;

(b) Share information and know-how on green purchasing and environmentally friendly products and services internationally;

(c) Harmonize the efforts of green purchasing and the development of environmentally friendly products and services from a global viewpoint.

The International Green Purchasing Network (IGPN) keeps its activities with the structure of Council Members, the Secretariat, Advisory Board members, Green Purchasing Networks members and Associated members on the basis of the By-Laws.

The International Green Purchasing Network (IGPN) works with its members, Green Purchasing Networks from Japan, Korea, Thailand, Malaysia, Singapore, the Philippines, India, Vietnam, China, China Hong Kong, and Chinese Taipei etc., through:

(a) Collect and deliver global green purchasing activities, the best practices and latest trends

(b) Hold workshops and webinars regularly in regions

(c) Collaboration for development of tools for international use

(d) Other activities
