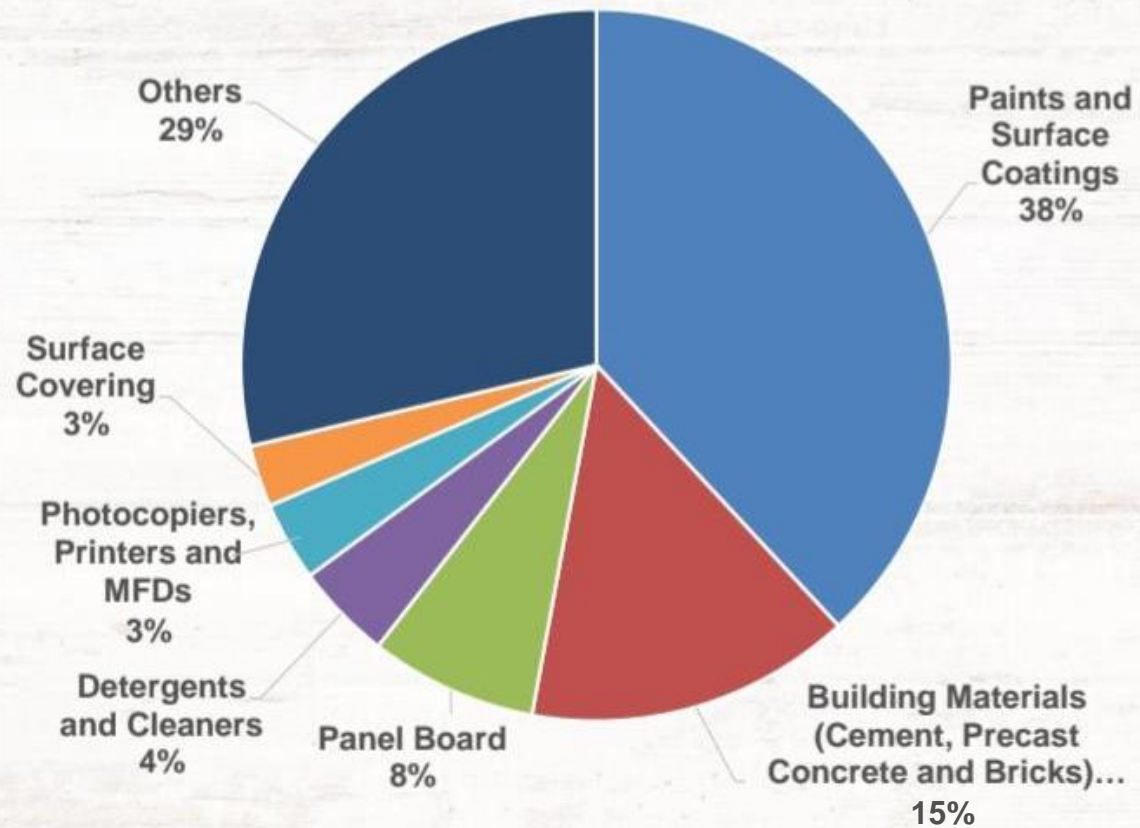

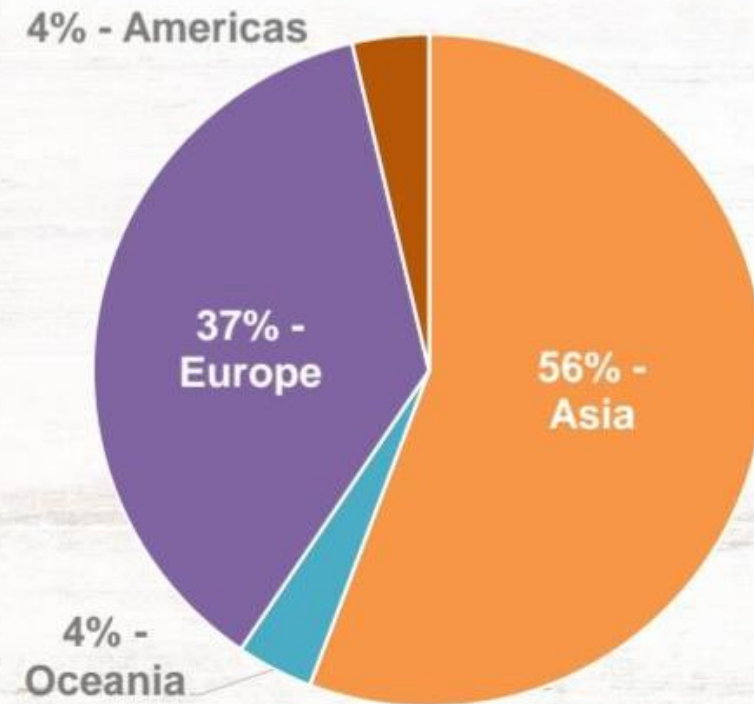


# Eco-Labeling Market Share

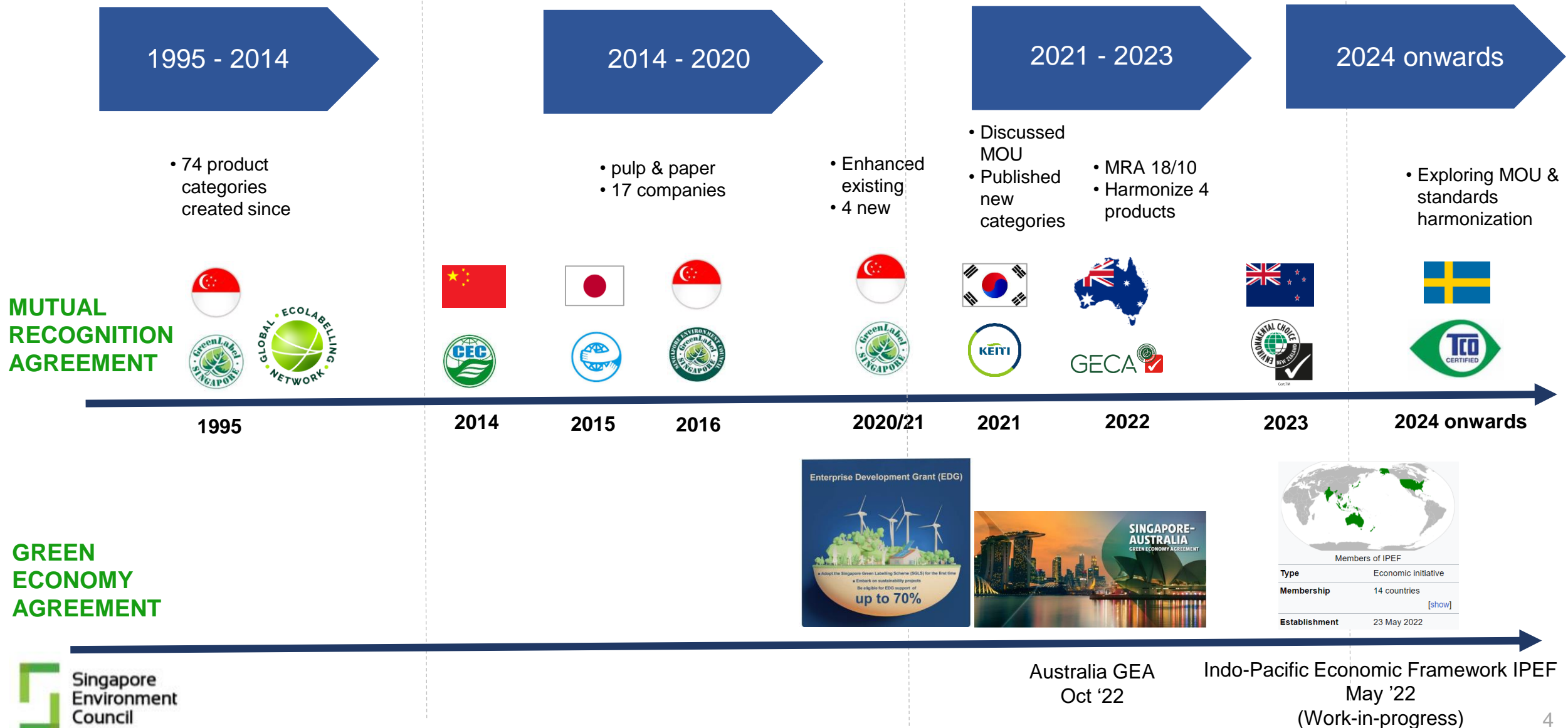


## The MyHijau Mark

# SEC-JEA Japan Eco Mark MRA (Update Nov 2023)



- Signing 1<sup>st</sup> December 2023
- Working on 3 product categories – Projectors, Imaging Equipment (Printers & Copiers) & Tile Carpets (Building Materials)
- Sharing of Projector & Imaging Equipment criteria for mutual recognition
- Work-in-progress – To establish certification of Japan criteria in SGLS so that products can be distributed in SEA region with English markings under SGP jurisdiction. 2024 April to review harmonising the labels
- Aim to land May 2024 to launch

# SEC-KEITI Korea Eco-Label MRA (Update Nov 2023)



- Rekindled conversations for MRA signing from year 2020.
- Working on mutual recognition of certifications for copying machines, printers, fax machines and multi-functional devices.
- Propose for products under the Korea Eco-label Standards to be automatically accepted for certification under Singapore Green Label Scheme, and vice versa for sustainable green procurement for government.
- Work-in-progress – MRA draft to be signed Feb 2024. To complete and launch immediately (conversion of their Korean label to SEC label).

# SEC-GECA MOU Action Plan (Update Nov 2023)



## A. Harmonising standards

- As gaps are wide, subject to demand, potential for SEC to certify Singapore products seeking GECA certification using GECA's Criteria, and vice versa
- harmonising standards to create
  - ✓ opportunity for cross-trade that meet green procurement objectives
  - ✓ drive uptake for ecolabel products
- to focus on standards that will impact more commercial companies e.g. construction & office equipment
- Conducted gap analysis of each other's eco-label standards for paints, cement and concrete products, and multi-functional devices

## B. Creating a roadmap to help achieve overall countries' climate goals

- the Green Economy Agreement (GEA) has a strong focus on climate related activities
- to add GHG emission criteria to ecolabels to align with governments climate goals
- SEC is a member of GECA's Technical Advisory Group, and has provided inputs for proposed criterion on carbon emission with prior management
  - ✓ the proposed carbon emission criterion would essentially require applicants seeking certification to provide info on how they intend to reduce the carbon footprint of the product to be certified
  - ✓ Work in progress – stalled with new management

# SEC-TCO MOU for Collaboration (Update Nov 2023)



- MOU signed 9 November 2023
- Working on EU’s Sustainable Public Procurement (SPP) for ICT electronics equipment and products – in line with GreenGov.SG and SGP Green Label Products access EU
- With GHG emission criteria, faster alignment to governments climate goals
