
 Increasing recognition of **food** procurement as a development tool and as an entry point to trigger more sustainable food systems





Global Review of Sustainable Public Procurement

- Food and catering services are among the main sectors prioritized by governments to include sustainability criteria in their public procurement activities
- 2nd position of governments' priorities on SPP





Public food procurement initiatives











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Rationale

Depending on the choices around :

- What food to purchase
- From whom
- From what type of production practices

PFP can influence both **food consumption and food production patterns** and to deliver **multiple social**, economic and/or environmental benefits to a multiplicity of beneficiaries

- Focus on school food procurement




Connecting the dots: leveraging existing collaborative networks
